California 93230, hereby make application for permission to change the Point of Diversion and Place of Use

of water heretofore appropriated under Permit Number 35258, Certificate Number 9574

(Identify existing right by Permit, Certificate, Proof or Claim Nos. If Decreed, give title of Decree and identify right in Decree.)

- 1. The source of water is underground
2. The amount of water to be changed 4.46 c.f.s.
3. The water to be used for irrigation and domestic
4. The water heretofore used for irrigation and domestic
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 32, T.25N., R.41E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the Southwest corner bears S86°15'W 2,715'.
6. The existing point of diversion is located within SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 32, T.25N., R.41E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the Southwest corner of said Section 32 bears S21°30'W, a distance of 2,975'.
7. Proposed place of use All of Sections 31 and 32, T.25N., R.41E., M.D.B. & M. 1.190.15 acres, more or less. EXCEPTING THEREFROM, the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 32, T.25N., R.41E., M.D.B. & M.
8. Existing place of use 40 acres in the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 32, T.25N., R.41E., M.D.B. & M. 80 acres in the S 1/2 NW 1/4 of Section 32, T.25N., R.41E., M.D.B. & M. 160 acres in the NE 1/4 of Section 32, T.25N., R.41E., M.D.B. & M. 280 ACRES TOTAL
9. Use will be from January 1st to December 31st of each year.
10. Use has been from January 1st to December 31st of each year.
11. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) Drill well, pump, motor, 10" pipeline, sprinkler system and culverts.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 35258, Certificate 9574, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 35258, Certificate 9574, and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a measuring device must be installed in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

Water under this permit is supplemental to rights under Permits 44577, 44578, 44579, 44580, and 45329 for use on 1,189.62 acres described under the place of use of these permits. The total diversion rate and annual duty from this permit and Permits 44577, 44578, 44579, 44580, and 45329 shall not exceed 21.362 cubic feet per second or 4,758.48 acre-feet per annum, respectively.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed.....4.46.....cubic feet per second, but not to exceed a yearly duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources and not to exceed 1,120 acre-feet annually.
