waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.)

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Underground Name of stream, lake, spring, underground or other source

2. The amount of water applied for is 0.1 cfs second-foot One second-foot equals 448.83 gals. per min.

3. The water to be used for Commercial and Domestic Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic, or other use. Must limit to one use.

The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 20, T 45 N, R 64 E, MDB & M., at a point from which the W 1/4 corner of said Section 220 bears survey, and by course and distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be so stated. N 45° 54' 11" W 2698.32 feet.

6. Place of use A portion of the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 20, T 45 N, R 64 E, MDB & M. Describe by legal subdivision. If on unsurveyed land, it should be so stated.

7. Use will begin about January 1 and end about December 31, of each year. Month and Day Month and Day

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) Well, Pipelines and Storage Tank State manner in which water is to be diverted, i.e. diversion structure, ditches and flumes, drilled well with pump and motor, etc.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to existing rights. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before the use of water begins, or before the Proof of Completion of Work is filed. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer, pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State Federal and local agencies.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.10 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 11.5 million gallons annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before August 31, 1983

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before October 1, 1983

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before August 31, 1986

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before October 1, 1986
