hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.) New York, 1917

9. Estimated cost of works \$35,000

10. Estimated time required to construct works five years

11. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use eight years
