The applicant Bureau of Land Management, Winnemucca District, 705 East Fourth St.
of Winnemucca, NV 89445
hereby make S. application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated.

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Crescent Well, an underground source

2. The amount of water applied for is .025 second-feet

(a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet

3. The water to be used for stockwatering, other uses, wild horses, wildlife-rangeland uses

4. If use is for:

(a) Irrigation, state number of acres to be irrigated:

(b) Stockwater, state number and kinds of animals to be watered: 350 cattle

5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: S.E. 1/4 N.W. 1/4 of Section 33 T. 38N., R. 35E., M.D.B.&M. At a point from which the W. 1/4 corner of Section 19 T. 38N., R. 35E. bears N. 49°10'13" W. 15,572.00 feet.

6. Place of use S. 1/2, N.W. 1/4, of Section 33 T. 38N., R. 35E., M.D.B. & M.

7. Use will begin about January 1 and end about December 31 of each year.

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) (Existing) Well, 8" casing, windmill and 30' diameter x 2' deep steel trough

9. Estimated cost of works \$5715.17

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the period of use and the average number of livestock served from the waters of this source. It is further understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level at permittee's well due to any other ground water development in the area. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening for measuring depth to water. If well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times but does not take responsibility for the use of the Federal range.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This permit is issued with the express understanding and on the condition that existing grazing use of the public range by authorized users or permittees will not be impaired or adversely affected by approval and issuance of this permit.
