hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.) Pennsylvania - August 9, 1922

6. Place of use All of Section 33-T30N-R46E, M.D.B.&M. and lots 3 and 4, Portion of lot 2, Portion of S 1/2 NW 1/4, Portion of SW 1/4 NE 1/4, Portion of E 1/2 SW 1/4, Portion of SE 1/4 Section 4; Portion of N 1/2 NE 1/4, Portion of NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 9-T29N-R46E, M.D.B.&M.

7. Use will begin about January 1 and end about December 31, of each year.

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) pipe to small reservoir (less than 10 acre feet) then piped and hauled to drill sites

9. Estimated cost of works \$6,000.00

10. Estimated time required to construct works three years

During exploration it is estimated that 4,000 gallons per day, 20 days per month, 10 months per year will be used. Should this property be developed into an economical mining property, this water would be used for milling.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to existing rights. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of water begins, or before the Proof of Completion of Work is filed. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer, pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit is issued under the preferred use provisions of NRS Chapter 534. The manner of use of water under this permit is by nature of its activity a temporary use and any application to change the manner of use granted under this permit will be subject to additional determination and evaluation with respect to the permanent effects on existing rights and the resource within the ground water basin. The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies. The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and

not to exceed 0.5 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed .8 million gallons annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before August 31, 1984

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before October 1, 1984

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before August 31, 1987

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before October 1, 1987
