The applicant GOLD FIELDS MINING CORPORATION

hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.) Articles of Incorporation on file with the Delaware Secretary of State in 1927.

- 1. The source of the proposed appropriation is underground.
2. The amount of water applied for is 0.5 c.f.s. second-feet
3. The water to be used for mining, milling and domestic
4. If use is for: (a) Irrigation, state number of acres to be irrigated: (b) Stockwater, state number and kinds of animals to be watered: mining, milling and domestic (c) Other use (describe fully under "No. 12. Remarks" (d) Power: (1) Horsepower developed (2) Point of return of water to stream
5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 6 (partially unsurveyed) T.28N., R.43E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the Northeast corner of said Section 6 bears N45°56' E 2,157'.
6. Place of use Sections 2, 3, 10 and 11, T.28N., R.42E., M.D.B.&M., (unsurveyed)
7. Use will begin about January 1st and end about December 31st, of each year.
8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) Drilled well.
9. Estimated cost of works in excess of \$1,000.00.

10. Estimated time required to construct works..... three (3) years  
If well completed, describe works.

11. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use..... five (5) years

12. Remarks: For use other than irrigation or stock watering, state number and type of units to be served or annual consumptive use.

Estimated use will be 225 gallons per minute; eight hours per day; 365 days a year, or approximately 39,420,000 gallons annually. Water appropriated will be used for exploration purposes. Also, for mining, milling and domestic.
