APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the 0.25 c.f.s., herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to a beneficial use. A suitable measuring device must be installed and accurate measurements of the water placed to a beneficial use must be included in the proof of such use when filed. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This Permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 15861, 16358, 45349, 45350, 45351 and 45353 shall not exceed 1,200 acre feet annually.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and

not to exceed 0.25 cubic feet per second, and not to exceed a yearly duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources, but not to exceed 181 acre feet annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before January 12, 1992

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before February 12, 1992

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before January 12, 1994

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before February 12, 1994

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before February 12, 1994
