(If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.)

2. The amount of water applied for is 4.5 cfs second-foot One second-foot equals 448.83 gals. per min.

The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: in the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 3, T.11N., R.56E., M.D.B.&M., whence the Southeast Corner of said Section 3 bears S. 19° 32' 04" E., 4,741.17 feet distant. Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey, and by course and distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be so stated.

6. Place of use the S 1/2 NE 1/4, N 1/2 NW 1/4, portions of the S 1/2 NW 1/4 of Section 2; N 1/2 NE 1/4, the SW 1/4 NE 1/4, portions of the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 3; T.11N., R.56E., M.D.B.&M. SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 34; S 1/2 SW 1/4 of Section 35; T.12N., R.56E., M.D.B.&M. Describe by legal subdivision. If on unsurveyed land, it should be so stated.

7. Use will begin about January 1st and end about December 31st, of each year. Month and Day Month and Day

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level at permittee's well due to other ground water development in the area. A substantial weir or other type of measuring device must be installed and measurements of water use kept. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening for measuring depth to water. If well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 4.5 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed a yearly duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before August 6, 1987

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before September 6, 1987

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before August 6, 1991

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before September 6, 1991

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before September 6, 1991
