1. The source of water is Carson River Name of stream, lake, underground spring or other source.

2. The amount of water to be changed 0.137 c.f.s. Second feet, acre feet. One second foot equals 448.83 gallons per minute.

3. The water to be used for As Decreed Irrigation, power, mining, industrial, etc. If for stock state number and kind of animals.

4. The water heretofore permitted for As Decreed Irrigation, power, mining, industrial, etc. If for stock state number and kind of animals.

5. The water is to be diverted at the following point The Dayton Town Ditch on the north bank of the Carson River in the NW corner of the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 4, T.15N., R.21E., M.D.B.&M. Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey and by course and distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be stated.

6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within No change If point of diversion is not changed, do not answer.

7. Proposed place of use portion SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 27, T.16N., R.21E., M.D.B.&M. (5.9 acres) Describe by legal subdivisions. If for irrigation state number of acres to be irrigated.

8. Existing place of use portion NW 1/4 SE 1/4 (5.1 ac.) and SW 1/4 SE 1/4 (0.8 ac.) Section 27, T.16N., R.21E., M.D.B.&M. (That portion within the W 1/2 SE 1/4 of said Section 27 described under Claim 717, Carson River Final Decree) Describe by legal subdivisions. If permit is for irrigation, state number of acres irrigated. If changing place of use and/or manner of use of irrigation permit, describe acreage to be removed from irrigation.

9. Use will be from As Decreed to of each year. Month and Day Month and Day

11. Description of proposed works. This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the place of use of a portion of the waters of the Carson River as heretofore granted under Permit 27191 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 27191, and United States vs. Alpine Land and Reservoir Company, Civil D-183 BRT (Final Carson River Decree) and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. A substantial headgate and measuring device must be installed and maintained to facilitate the measurements and control of water. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water under this proposed change at any and all times.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.137 cubic feet per second as decreed.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before February 19, 1986

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before March 19, 1986

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before February 19, 1989

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before March 19, 1989
