The applicant Candelaria Metals, Inc. 787 N. Main St. Bldg B, of Bishop, California 93514

hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.) Nevada March 20, 1980

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Unnamed Springs

2. The amount of water applied for is .25 second-feet

(a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet .5

The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: A spring located on that parcel described as the SE 1/4 of the SE 1/4, Sect. 1, in the unsurveyed T1S, R32E, MDBM protracted survey, and by course and distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be so stated. off the Benton NE, Nev., quadrangle map, 7.5 minute series, dated 1978 on unsurveyed land, or at a point which the S.W. cor. Sec 26 R32E, T1N MDB&M bears N34°-31'W 13,058.0

6. Place of use SE 1/4 Section 26 T1N R32E MDB&M

7. Use will begin about January 1 and end about December 31, of each year.

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) Collect by spring box and pipe to small reservoir (1/2 acre feet) at place of use.

9. Estimated cost of works 20,000

10. Estimated time required to construct works 8 months
If well completed, describe works.

11. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use 12 months

12. Remarks: For use other than irrigation or stock watering, state number and type of units to be served or annual consumptive use.

To be used for underground mining, drilling and dust control; mill circuits, fine grinding, flotation cells, slurry transport, etc. Approximately 50% .125 second-feet will be consumptively used, balance will be returned to surface flow, 24 hours per day 365 days per year, 678 acre ft. per year consumptively used.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the .25 c.f.s., herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to a beneficial use. A suitable measuring device must be installed and accurate measurements of the water placed to a beneficial use must be included in the proof of such use when filed. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This Permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under this permit and Permit 45564 shall not exceed 362 acre-feet annually.

This permit is subject to the condition that the permittee must ensure that wildlife which have customarily used such water will have access thereto, NRS 533.367.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal, and local agencies.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed .25 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 181.0 acre-feet annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before August 6, 1986

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before September 6, 1986

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before August 6, 1989

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before September 6, 1989

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before September 6, 1989
