Manner and Place of Use of a Portion Point of diversion, manner of use, and/or place of use

of water heretofore appropriated under Permit 27614 (Identify existing right by Permit, Certificate, Proof or Claim Nos. If Decreed, give title of Decree and

identify right in Decree.)

1. The source of water is Underground Name of stream, lake, underground spring or other source.

2. The amount of water to be changed 0.53 CFS Second feet, acre feet. One second foot equals 448.83 gallons per minute.

3. The water to be used for Quasi-Municipal (Highway Construction) Irrigation, power, mining, industrial, etc. If for stock state number and kind of animals.

4. The water heretofore permitted for Irrigation and Domestic Irrigation, power, mining, industrial, etc. If for stock state number and kind of animals.

5. The water is to be diverted at the following point SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 35, T. 14 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 35 bears distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be stated. North 00° 45' 58" West, 4,058.38 feet (no change)

6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 35, T. 14 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 35 bear North 00° 45' 58" West, 4,058.38 feet.

7. Proposed place of use S 1/2 NW 1/4 SE 1/4, S 1/2 NE 1/4 SE 1/4, SW 1/4 SE 1/4, and the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 all in Section 35, Township 14 North, Range 20 East, M.D.B. & M., Douglas County, Nevada

8. Existing place of use from which water rights are to be removed - Portion NE 1/4 SW 1/4, NW 1/4 SW 1/4, SW 1/4 SW 1/4 and SE 1/4 SW 1/4, all in Section 35, Township 14 North, Range 20 East, M.D.B. & M., Douglas County, Nevada (50 acres total)

9. Use will be from January 1 to December 31 of each year.

10. Use was permitted from January 1 to December 31 of each year.

11. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) Existing well, pump and motor and new pipelines to the proposed place of use.

12. Estimated cost of works \$10,000

13. Estimated time required to construct works one year

- 14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use..... one year

Permits 27614 and 28629 are for irrigation and domestic purpose and cover the same place of use. It is the intent of this Application and the Application to change Permit 28619 to transfer 200 AC. FT. (50 acres x 4.0 AC. FT. per acre) to the new place of use for a gravel plant operation.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the manner of use and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 27614 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 27614 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This Permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under this permit and Permit 45569 shall not exceed 72.0 acre-feet per annum.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.19 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 72.0 acre-feet annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before September 6, 1983

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before October 6, 1983

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before September 6, 1984

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before October 6, 1984
