hereby make S application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.) Incorporated July 11, 1973 in Nevada

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Underground Name of stream, lake, spring, underground or other source

2. The amount of water applied for is one (1) C.F.S. second-feet One second-foot equals 448.83 gals. per min.

Or at a point for which the South 1/2 corner of said Section 3 bears survey, and by course and distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be so stated. S. 76° 30' E., a distance of 1364.0 feet.

6. Place of use SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 10 T.13N. R.26 E. Lyon County Nevada known as El Rancho Estates, Lots #1 thru #102 and Parcels A;B;C; & D; and E 1/2 SW 1/4 Section 3 and NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 10 T.13N., R.26E. MDB&M. AND E 1/2 W 1/2 SE 1/4 Section 3, T. 13N., Range 26 E. and N 1/2 NE 1/4 Section 10, T.13N., Range 26 E., MDB & M. Lyon County, Nevada.

7. Use will begin about January 1st and end about December 31st, of each year. Month and Day

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) Well, Pump & Distribution State manner in which water is to be diverted, i.e. diversion structure, ditches and flumes, drilled well with pump and motor, etc.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This permit is issued subject to existing rights. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of water begins, or before the Proof of Completion of Work is filed. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer, pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The total combined duty of water under this permit and Permit 31565, Certificate 9865; 41985; 45717, and 45718 shall not exceed 47.48 million gallons annually.

The combined annual duty will be to serve 142 lots of which 106 lots are located in El Rancho Estates No.1 Subdivision and 36 lots located in Southview Estates Units 1, 2, and 3.

The place of use of Permits 45717 and 45718 will not include Lots 1, 2, 3, 5, 6, 7, 12, 15, 16, 17, 18, 20, 23, 24, 34, and 39 of Southview Estates Units 1, 2 and 3. The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and

not to exceed 1.0 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 47.48 million gallons annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before August 28, 1985

Proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before September 28, 1985

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before August 28, 1987

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before September 28, 1987

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before September 28, 1987

Completion of work filed NOV 1 1989

Proof of beneficial use filed
