Nevada 89005, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public

waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.) Nevada, February 9, 1967

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Underground Name of stream, lake, spring, underground or other source

2. The amount of water applied for is 0.076 cfs second-feet One second-foot equals 448.83 gals. per min.

3. The water to be used for Quasi-Municipal Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic, or other use. Must limit to one use.

5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 35, T 42 N, R 52 E, MDB & M., at a point from which the W 1/2 corner of said Section 35 bears S 82° 29' 32" W 1952.28 feet.

6. Place of use Portions of the SE 1/4 NW 1/4, N 1/2 SW 1/4, SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 35, T 42 N, R 52 E, MDB & M.

7. Use will begin about January 1 and end about December 31, of each year.

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) Well, Pipelines with a storage tank.

9. Estimated cost of works \$20,000

10. Estimated time required to construct works 3 years
If well completed, describe works.

11. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use 5 years

12. Remarks: For use other than irrigation or stock watering, state number and type of units to be served or annual consumptive use.

This water is to be used for the existing Jack Creek Unit No. 1 Subdivision. The lots have been used for vacation short time occupancy.

Estimated annual consumptive use is 4,410,000 gallons per year.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to existing rights. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of water begins or before the Proof of Completion of Work is filed.

This Permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

No perforations shall be put in the production casing from ground level to 100 feet.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal, and local agencies.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.076 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 17.8 million gallons annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before September 2, 1984

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before October 2, 1984

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before September 2, 1987

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before October 2, 1987

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before
