1. The source of water is Underground (Fox well) Name of stream, lake, underground spring or other source.

2. The amount of water to be changed 0.925 c.f.s. (65.17 mga) Second feet, acre feet. One second foot equals 448.83 gallons per minute.

3. The water to be used for Municipal Irrigation, power, mining, industrial, etc. If for stock state number and kind of animals.

4. The water heretofore permitted for Quasi-municipal & Domestic Irrigation, power, mining, industrial, etc. If for stock state number and kind of animals.

5. The water is to be diverted at the following point SW 1/4 SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 28, T.19 S., R.53 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the center 1/4 corner of said Section 28 bears distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be stated. South 08°01'52" West, a distance of 618.36 feet.

6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 33, T.19 S., R.53 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the Northeast corner of said Section 33 bears North 82°59'33" East, a distance of 404.11 feet. (McGowan - 2 Well)

Existing place of use E 1/2 SW 1/4 Section 14; all of Section 23; N 1/2, W 1/2 SW 1/4 Section 24; W 1/2, W 1/2 SE 1/4 Section 26; S 1/2, S 1/2 N 1/2, NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 27; SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 28; NW 1/4, N 1/2 NE 1/4 Section 33; N 1/2 NW 1/4 Section 34; all in T.19 S., R.53 E., M.D.B. & M. as shown on the supporting map.

9. Use will be from January 1 to December 31 of each year.

10. Use was permitted from January 1 to December 31 of each year.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion, place of use, and manner of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 38554 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 38554 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The total combined duty of water under this permit and Permits 46118, 46119, and 46121 shall not exceed 469.0 million gallons annually.

The total combined duty of water under this permit and Permits 46115, 46116, 46117, 46118, 46119, and 46121 shall not exceed 860.02 million gallons annually.

The total combined amount of water granted under this permit and Permit 46121 is limited to what the well covered under the two permits is capable of producing. If certificates of appropriation are issued under this permit and Permit 46121, the total combined amount of appropriation granted in said certificates shall not exceed what the well covered under the two permits is capable of producing.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.925 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 65.17 million gallons annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before April 29, 1984

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before May 29, 1984

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before April 29, 1986

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before May 29, 1986
