1. The source of water is Underground Name of stream, lake, underground spring or other source.

2. The amount of water to be changed 1.21 CFS Second feet, acre feet. One second foot equals 448.83 gallons per minute.

3. The water to be used for Irrigation and Domestic Irrigation, power, mining, industrial, etc. If for stock state number and kind of animals.

4. The water heretofore permitted for Irrigation and Domestic Irrigation, power, mining, industrial, etc. If for stock state number and kind of animals.

5. The water is to be diverted at the following point SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 7, T.35N., R.24E., MDB&M or Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey and by course and at a point from which the North 1/4 corner of said Section 7 bears N.43°05'28"E. distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be stated. 1720.13 feet.

6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within Lot 1 Section 7, T.35N., R.24E., MDB&M If point of diversion is not changed, do not answer. or at a point from which the West 1/4 corner of said Section 7 bears S.39°W. 1780 feet.

7. Proposed place of use Lots 1 and 2 Section 7, T.35N., R.24E., MDB&M (71.44 acres) Describe by legal subdivisions. If for irrigation state number of acres to be irrigated.

8. Existing place of use Same Describe by legal subdivisions. If permit is for irrigation, state number of acres irrigated. If changing place of use and/or manner of use of irrigation permit, describe acreage to be removed from irrigation.

9. Use will be from January 1 to December 31 of each year. Month and Day Month and Day

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 25905, Certificate 9464, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 25905, Certificate 9464 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a measuring device must be installed in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 1.21 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed a yearly duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before September 14, 1984

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before October 14, 1984

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before September 14, 1984

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before October 14, 1984

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before October 14, 1984
