Point of diversion, manner of use, and/or place of use of water heretofore appropriated under Permit No. 42629 (Identify existing right by Permit, Certificate, Proof or Claim Nos. If Decreed, give title of Decree and identify right in Decree.)

1. The source of water is underground Name of stream, lake, underground spring or other source.

2. The amount of water to be changed 2.66 CFS Second feet, acre feet. One second foot equals 448.83 gallons per minute.

3. The water to be used for irrigation Irrigation, power, mining, industrial, etc. If for stock state number and kind of animals.

4. The water heretofore permitted for irrigation Irrigation, power, mining, industrial, etc. If for stock state number and kind of animals.

The water is to be diverted at the following point SE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 3, T. 43 N., R. 31 E., M.D.B. & M.; or at a point which the SE corner of said Section 3 bears S 85° 38' E 905.00 feet Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey and by course and distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be stated.

6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within SE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 3, T. 43 N., R. 31 E., M.D.B. & M.; or at a point which the SE corner of said Section bears S 84° 53' 53" E 701.78 feet If point of diversion is not changed, do not answer.

7. Proposed place of use W 1/2 Section 35, T. 44 N., R. 31 E., M.D.B. & M., and NW 1/4 T. 43 N., R. 31 E., M.D.B. & M. 840 acres, more or less Describe by legal subdivisions. If for irrigation state number of acres to be irrigated.

8. Existing place of use NW 1/4 except Northerly 60 acres, Sec. 3, T. 43 N., R. 31 E., M.D.B. & M. 100 acres, more or less. All to remain under irrigation Describe by legal subdivisions. If permit is for irrigation, state number of acres irrigated. If changing place of use and/or manner of use of irrigation permit, describe acreage to be removed from irrigation.

9. Use will be from 1 January to 31 December of each year. Month and Day Month and Day

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 42629 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 42629 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a measuring device must be installed in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The total combined duty of water under this permit and Permits 46281, 46282, 46283, 46284 and 46285 shall not exceed 3560.68 acre-feet annually for irrigation of 890.17 acres.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not

to exceed 2.66 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed a yearly duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources and not to exceed 412.0 acre-feet annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before November 25, 1984

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before December 25, 1984

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before November 25, 1985

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before December 25, 1985

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before December 25, 1985
