hereby make application for permission to change the point of Diversion

Point of diversion, manner of use, and/or place of use Permit No. 41478

of water heretofore appropriated under (Identify existing right by Permit, Certificate, Proof or Claim Nos. If Decreed, give title of Decree and identify right in Decree.)

Identify right in Decree.

1. The source of water is underground Name of stream, lake, underground spring or other source.

2. The amount of water to be changed 0.25 c.f.s. Second feet, acre feet. One second foot equals 448.83 gallons per minute.

3. The water to be used for quasi-municipal Irrigation, power, mining, industrial, etc. If for stock state number and kind of animals.

4. The water heretofore permitted for quasi-municipal Irrigation, power, mining, industrial, etc. If for stock state number and kind of animals.

5. The water is to be diverted at the following point in the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 20, T.8 N., R.44 E., M.D.B. & M., whence the West 1/4 Corner of said Section 20 bears S.77°23'46"W., 3,813.01 feet distant.

6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 20, T.8 N., R.44 E., M.D.B. & M., Whence the West 1/4 Corner of said Section 20 bears N.64°41'20"W., 469.98 feet distant. (The original bearing on the application under 41478 was in error as stated N.69°41'20"W.)

7. Proposed place of use is the town of Manhattan situated in portions of Section 20 and the E 1/2 of Section 19, T.8 N., R.44 E., M.D.B. & M., as shown on supporting map.

8. Existing place of use is the town of Manhattan situated in portions of Section 20 and the E 1/2 of Section 19, T.8 N., R.44 E., M.D.B. & M., as shown on supporting map.

9. Use will be from January 1st to December 31st of each year.

10. Use was permitted from January 1st to December 31st of each year.

11. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) It is proposed to drill, case and equip an underground well and pump to an above ground storage tank, and pipe to an existing water main in the Town of Manhattan, Nye County, Nevada.

12. Estimated cost of works \$25,000.00

13. Estimated time required to construct works one (1) year

14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use one (1) year

15. Remarks: For use other than irrigation or stock watering, state number and type of units to be served or annual consumptive use.

An estimated 150 dwellings are to be served in conjunction with existing water rights. The well at existing point of diversion proved to be unsuccessful after test pumping and necessitated this change.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 41478 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 41478 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the Proof of Completion of Work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.25 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 54.75 million gallons annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before July 21, 1984

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before August 21, 1984

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before October 16, 1986

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before November 16, 1986
