1. The source of water is Underground Name of stream, lake, underground spring or other source.

2. The amount of water to be changed 2.7 cfs Second feet, acre feet. One second foot equals 448.83 gallons per minute.

3. The water to be used for Irrigation and Domestic Irrigation, power, mining, industrial, etc. If for stock state number and kind of animals.

4. The water heretofore permitted for Irrigation and Domestic Irrigation, power, mining, industrial, etc. If for stock state number and kind of animals.

5. The water is to be diverted at the following point in the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 24, T. 24 N. R. 40 E., M.D.B. &M., or at a point from which the West 1/2 corner of said Section 24 bears distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be stated. S. 62°09' W. a distance of 2965.6 feet.

6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 24, T. 24 N., R. 40 E., M.D.B. &M., or at a point from which the West 1/2 corner of said Section 24 bears S. 88°37' W. a distance of 2706.20 feet.

7. Proposed place of use N 1/2 Section 24, T. 24 N., R. 40 E., M.D.B. &M. Describe by legal subdivisions. If for irrigation state number of acres to be irrigated. (320 Acres)

8. Existing place of use N 1/2 Section 24, T. 24 N., R. 40 E., M.D.B. & M. Describe by legal subdivisions. If permit is for irrigation, state number of acres irrigated. If changing place of use and/or manner of use of irrigation permit, describe acreage to be removed from irrigation. (320 acres)

9. Use will be from January 1 to December 31 of each year. Month and Day Month and Day

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 29817 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 29817 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a measuring device must be installed in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 2.7 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed a yearly duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before August 12, 1984

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before September 12, 1984

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before August 12, 1984

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before September 12, 1984

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before September 12, 1984

Completion of work filed NOV 6 1984

Proof of beneficial use filed NOV 6 1984
