APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions;

This permit is issued subject to existing rights. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of water begins, or before the Proof of Completion of Work is filed. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer, pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times. The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.001 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 0.73 acre-feet annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before December 10, 2000

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before January 10, 2001

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before December 10, 2003

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before January 10, 2004
