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**APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER**

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the period of use and the average number of livestock served from the waters of this source. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times but does not take responsibility for the use of the Federal range.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 46741, 46742 and 46743 shall not exceed 11.8 acre-feet annually.

This permit is subject to the condition that the permittee must ensure that wildlife which has customarily used such water will have access thereto, NRS 533.367.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

Permit 46741 (Page Spring), Permit 46742 (Upper Warm Spring) and Permit 46743 (Pat Spring) are issued for stockwatering purposes for the same 528 cattle and are 100% supplemental. It is further understood that the amount of water herein granted is limited to the amount of water actually produced by the spring, and no rights in excess of that amount are implied or inferred.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:


