Point of Diversion and Place of Use of a Portion Point of diversion, manner of use, and/or place of use

of water heretofore appropriated under Permit 29143, PBU filed (Identify existing right by Permit, Certificate, Proof or Claim No. If Decreed, give title of Decree and identify right in Decree.)

1. The source of water is underground Name of stream, lake, underground spring or other source.

2. The amount of water to be changed 0.287 CFS Second feet, acre feet. One second foot equals 448.83 gallons per minute.

3. The water to be used for Irrigation and domestic Irrigation, power, mining, industrial, etc. If for stock state number and kind of animals.

4. The water heretofore permitted for Irrigation and domestic Irrigation, power, mining, industrial, etc. If for stock state number and kind of animals.

5. The water is to be diverted at the following point within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 24, T.30N., R.22E., MDB&M or at a point from which the East 1/4 corner of said Section 24 bears S.86°28'58"E. 2627.89 feet. (well 3)

6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 13, T.30N., R.22E., MDB&M or at a point from which the South 1/4 corner of said Section 13 bears S.00°11'50"W. 2635.5 feet. (well 4)

7. Proposed place of use NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 13, T.30N., R.22E., MDB&M 17 acres. Describe by legal subdivisions. If for irrigation state number of acres to be irrigated.

8. Existing place of use Section 13, T.30N., R.22E., MDB&M: NE 1/4 NW 1/4 (8.5 ac.), SE 1/4 NW 1/4 (8.5 ac.)--Total 17 acres. Describe by legal subdivisions. If permit is for irrigation, state number of acres irrigated. If changing place of use and/or manner of use of irrigation permit, describe acreage to be removed from irrigation.

9. Use will be from January 1 to December 31 of each year. Month and Day

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 29143 (Certificate 10666) is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 29143 (Certificate 10666) and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.244 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 68.0 acre-feet annually, and not to exceed a yearly duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before March 29, 1997

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before April 29, 1997

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before March 29, 1999

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before April 29, 1999

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before April 29, 1999
