Street and No. or P.O. Box No. City or Town State and Zip Code No. hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.)

February 6, 1974, in Carson City, Nevada

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Layton Spring No. 1 Name of stream, lake, spring, underground or other source

2. The amount of water applied for is 0.01 CFS second-feet One second-foot equals 448.83 gals. per min.

3. The water to be used for Stockwater purposes (250 cows) Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic, or other use. Must limit to one use.

The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 11, T. 41 N., R. 43 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the East (E 1/4) one quarter corner of said Section 11 bears N 58° 09' E, a distance of 1,125 feet. Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey, and by course and distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be so stated.

6. Place of use NE 1/4 SE 1/4 and the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 11, T. 41 N., R. 43 E., M.D.B. & M. Describe by legal subdivision, if an unsurveyed land, it should be so stated.

7. Use will begin about January 1 and end about December 31, of each year. Month and Day

8. Description of proposed works. APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the period of use and the average number of livestock served from the waters of this source. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times but does not take responsibility for the use of the Federal range.

This Permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

This permit is subject to the condition that the permittee must ensure that wildlife which have customarily used such water will have access thereto, NRS 533.367.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal, and local agencies.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.0079 cubic feet per second of sufficient water to water 250 head of cattle.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before November 9, 1984

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before December 9, 1984

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before November 9, 1986

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before December 9, 1986
