APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 29767 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 29767 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The place of use is limited to 732.21 acres south of the south right of way line of I-80. This permit is subject to an agreement dated March 27, 1984 between John B. Dufurrena and Joan Dufurrena and Joseph Gene Baum and Lois Baum recorded as document 239185, Book 185, Page 246, Humboldt County Records.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.3744 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed a yearly duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before March 30, 1984

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before April 30, 1984

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before July 5, 1984

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before August 5, 1984

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before August 5, 1984

Proof of beneficial use filed AUG 15 1985
