1. The source of water is Underground Name of stream, lake, underground spring or other source.

2. The amount of water to be changed .038 c.f.s. Second feet, acre feet. One second foot equals 448.83 gallons per minute.

3. The water to be used for Irrigation and Domestic Irrigation, power, mining, industrial, etc. If for stock state number and kind of animals.

4. The water heretofore permitted for Irrigation and Domestic Irrigation, power, mining, industrial, etc. If for stock state number and kind of animals.

5. The water is to be diverted at the following point SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 2, T.21S., R.53E., M.D.B.&M., Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey and by course and or at a point from which the N 1/4 corner of said Section 2 bears North 55° 12' distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be stated. 00" East, a distance of 2986 feet

6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within NE 1/4 NW 1/4 (Lot 3) Section 2, T.21S., R.53E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the N 1/4 corner of said Section 2 bears North 41° 41' 15" East, a distance of 109.80 feet

7. Proposed place of use NW 1/4 SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 2, T.21S., R.53E., M.D.B.&M., 3.0 acres Describe by legal subdivisions. If for irrigation state number of acres to be irrigated. total (Lots 15, 16, 17, & 18 of Block F; Game Bird Subdivision)

8. Existing place of use 19.2 acres in Government Lot 4, Section 2, 19.0 acres in Government Lot 3, Section 2, T.21S., R.53E., M.D.B.&M., 38.2 acres total. (3.0 acres to be stripped from manner of use of irrigation permit, describe acreage to be removed from irrigation. Lots 2, 30 & 31 of Block B, Game Bird Subdivision)

9. Use will be from January 1 to December 31 of each year.

10. Use was permitted from January 1 to December 31 of each year.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 21660, Certificate 7286 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 21660, Certificate 7286 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The place of use is limited to 3 acres within lots 15, 16, 17, and 18 of Block F Game Bird Subdivision.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.038 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed a yearly duty of 5.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before November 5, 1987

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before December 5, 1987

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before November 5, 1988

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before December 5, 1988

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before December 5, 1988
