of water heretofore appropriated under Permit No. 40416 (Identify existing right by Permit, Certificate, Proof or Claim Nos. If Decreed, give title of Decree and identify right in Decree.)

1. The source of water is underground Name of stream, lake, underground spring or other source.

2. The amount of water to be changed 0.10 cfs Second feet, acre feet. One second foot equals 448.83 gallons per minute.

3. The water to be used for Quasi-Municipal Irrigation, power, mining, industrial, etc. If for stock state number and kind of animals.

4. The water heretofore permitted for Quasi Municipal Irrigation, power, mining, industrial, etc. If for stock state number and kind of animals.

5. The water is to be diverted at the following point N 1/2 N 1/2 NW 1/4 (N 1/2 N 1/2 Lot #2) Sec. 30, T14NR20E MDB&M at a point from which the NW corner of Sec. 18 T14NR20E MDB&M bears N 01° 20' 29" W 10,692 feet.

6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 30, T14NR20 E MDB&M at a point from which the NW corner of Sec. 18, T14NR20E MDB&M bears N 0° 36' 24" W 13,361 feet.

7. Proposed place of use N 1/2 N 1/2 NW 1/4 (N 1/2 N 1/2 Lot #1 and N 1/2 N 1/2 Lot # 2) Sec. 30, T14NR20E MDB&M

8. Existing place of use N 1/2 N 1/2 NW 1/4 (N 1/2 N 1/2 Lot # 1 and N 1/2 N 1/2 Lot #2) Describe by legal subdivisions. If permit is for irrigation, state number of acres irrigated. If changing place of use and/or manner of use of irrigation permit, describe acreage to be removed from irrigation.

9. Use will be from January 1 to December 31 of each year.

10. Use was permitted from January 1 to December 31 of each year.

11. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) Works described in Permit No. 40415, ie existing well, line shaft turbine pump and accessories, treatment, storage, pipes and flumes, or drilled well, etc. boosters and distribution.

14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use 4 years

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 40416 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 40416 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The total combined duty of this Permit and Permit 40415 shall not exceed 11.32 million gallons per annum.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.10 cubic feet per second, ~~but not to exceed 11.32~~ million gallons annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before December 17, 1984

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before January 17, 1985

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before December 17, 1987


