1. The source of water is Underground Name of stream, lake, underground spring or other source.

2. The amount of water to be changed 4.0 c.f.s. Second feet, acre feet. One second foot equals 448.83 gallons per minute.

3. The water to be used for Irrigation and Domestic purposes Irrigation, power, mining, industrial, etc. If for stock state number and kind of animals.

4. The water heretofore permitted for Irrigation and Domestic purposes Irrigation, power, mining, industrial, etc. If for stock state number and kind of animals.

5. The water is to be diverted at the following point NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 30, T.42N., R.40E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the NW corner of Section 18, T.42N., R.40E., M.D.B. & M., bears N 18° 35' W, a distance of 11,368 feet.

6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 30, T.42N., R.40E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the NW corner of Section 19, T.42N., R.40E., M.D.B. & M., bears N 22° 38' W, a distance of 10,577 feet.

7. Proposed place of use SW 1/4 SE 1/4, 30.8 ac., SE 1/4 SE 1/4, 10.3 ac., Section 30, NW 1/4 NE 1/4, 34.1 ac., NE 1/4 NE 1/4, 19.9 ac., SW 1/4 NE 1/4 33.5 ac., SE 1/4 NE 1/4, 19.6 ac., Section 31, all in T.42N., R.40E., M.D.B. & M., Humboldt County, Nevada.

8. Existing place of use SW 1/4 SE 1/4, 30.8 ac., SE 1/4 SE 1/4, 10.3 ac., Section 30, NW 1/4 NE 1/4, 34.1 ac., NE 1/4 NE 1/4, 19.9 ac., SW 1/4 NE 1/4 33.5 ac., SE 1/4 NE 1/4, 19.6 ac., Section 31, all in T.42N., R.40E., M.D.B. & M., Humboldt County, Nevada.

9. Use will be from January 1 to December 31 of each year.

10. Use was permitted from January 1 to December 31 of each year.

11. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) Steel cased well, 150 HP VS motor Layne & Bowler pump which are in place, irrigation pipe from the well to Indian Creek to be installed and irrigation ditches are in place.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 26059 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 26059 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This Permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

No perforations shall be put in the production casing from ground level to 100 feet.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

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The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not

to exceed 4.0 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 533.52 acre-feet annually, but not to exceed a yearly duty of 3.6 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before January 28, 1987

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before February 28, 1987

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before January 28, 1988

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before February 28, 1988

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before February 28, 1988
