1. The source of water is Underground Name of stream, lake, underground spring or other source.

2. The amount of water to be changed 1.45 cfs Second feet, acre feet. One second foot equals 448.83 gallons per minute.

3. The water to be used for Irrigation and Domestic Irrigation, power, mining, industrial, etc. If for stock state number and kind of animals.

4. The water heretofore permitted for Same as above Irrigation, power, mining, industrial, etc. If for stock state number and kind of animals.

5. The water is to be diverted at the following point Lot 5 (SW 1/4 NW 1/4) Section 29, T. 20 N. R. 53 E., MDB & M. at a point from which the W 1/4 corner of said Section 29 bears S 38° 51' 00" W 81.00 feet.

6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within Same as above If point of diversion is not changed, do not answer.

7. Proposed place of use Portions of Lot 1, All of Lots 2, 3 & 4, Portion of Lot 5, All of Lot 6, Portions of Lots 7 & 8, Section 29, T. 20 N., R. 53 E., MDB & M. Total acreage 317.54 acres

8. Existing place of use Lot 5 (41.8 acres), Lot 6 (42.2 acres), Lot 2 (42.06 acres), Total Acres 126.06 Section 29, T. 20 N., R. 53 E., MDB & M. Acres to be removed is 0.50 in Lot 5, T. 20 N., R. 53 E., MDB & M.

9. Use will be from January 1 to December 31 of each year.

10. Use was permitted from January 1 to December 31 of each year.

11. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) Well, Pipelines, Ditches and Sprinkler System

12. Estimated cost of works \$50,000

13. Estimated time required to construct works 3 years

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: This permit to change the place of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 35419 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 35419 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter, or any other measuring device acceptable to the State Engineer under Order No. 813, must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter, or any other measuring device acceptable to the State Engineer under Order No. 813, must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The total land to be irrigated under Permits 47518, 47519, 47520, and 47521 shall not exceed 317.54 acres and the total combined duty of these permits shall not exceed 1270.16 acre feet annually.

The issuance of this permit totally abrogates Permit 35419.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 1.45 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed a yearly duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources, and not to exceed an annual duty of 504.24 acre-feet.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before January 10, 1985

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before February 10, 1985

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before January 10, 1987

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before February 10, 1987

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before February 10, 1987
