APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the period of use and the average number of livestock served from the waters of this source. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times but does not take responsibility for the use of the Federal range.

This Permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.0046 cubic feet per second, or sufficient to water 150 head of cattle.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before November 15, 1991

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before December 15, 1991

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before November 15, 1993

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before December 15, 1993

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before N/A
