APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. A substantial headgate and measuring device must be installed and maintained to facilitate the measurement and control of water. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This Permit is issued supplemental to underground Permit 19191, Certificate 6824 and underground Permit 24214, Certificate 8174. Because the source of water under this permit is floodwater, the State Engineer makes no guarantee as to water availability and delivery.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 3.0 cubic feet per second or 1280 acre-feet seasonally, and not to exceed a yearly duty of 4 acre-feet per acre from any and/or all sources.**

March 4, 2010

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:



(If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.)

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Slough Creek (Intermittent) Name of stream, lake, spring, underground or other source

2. The amount of water applied for is 3 cfs second-feet One second-foot equals 448.83 gals. per min.

3. The water to be used for Irrigation Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic, or other use. Must limit to one use.

5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point Lot 1 Section 17, T20N, R53E, MDB & M., at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 17 bears S 0° 20' 00" W 709.32 feet. Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey, and by course and distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be so stated.

6. Place of use W 1/2 of Section 17, T20N, R53E, MDB & M. Describe by legal subdivision. If on unsurveyed land, it should be so stated.

7. Use will begin about March 1 and end about August 31, of each year. Month and Day Month and Day

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) Pipeline and Ditches, flood irrigation, storage reservoir. State manner in which water is to be diverted, i.e. diversion structure, ditches and flumes, drilled well with pump and motor, etc.

These waters are intermittent; during spring run off they cause considerable flooding on irrigated lands to the North. The water will be used supplemental to Certificates 8174 and 6825. We request to irrigate the total West 1/2 of Section T7, T20N, R53E, MDB&M., during that period when the creek is running, including that portion not covered by certificates 8174 and 6825.
