(If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.)

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Underground (Las Vegas Valley Artesian Basin) Name of stream, lake, spring, underground or other source

2. The amount of water applied for is 0.1 second-feet One second-foot equals 448.83 gals. per min.

(a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet.

3. The water to be used for Quasi-Municipal (4 residences) Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic, or other use. Must limit to one use.

4. If use is for:

(a) Irrigation, state number of acres to be irrigated.

(c) Other use (describe fully under "No. 12. Remarks")

(d) Power:

(1) Horsepower developed.

The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point in the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 35, Township 21 South, Range 60 East, Mount Diablo Meridian, Clark County, Nevada, at a point from which survey, and by course and distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be so stated. Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public the Center of the said Section 35 bears South 67° 50' 48" West a distance of 759.51 feet.

6. Place of use Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 35, Township 21 South, Range 60 East, Mount Diablo Meridian, Clark County, Nevada. Describe by legal subdivision. If on unsurveyed land, it should be so stated.

7. Use will begin about January 1 and end about December 31, of each year. Month and Day Month and Day

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to existing rights and is further subject to revocation if and when water can be furnished by an entity such as a water district or a municipality engaged in furnishing water. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of water begins, or before the Proof of Completion of Work is filed. It is understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening for measuring depth to water. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.10 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 1.46 million gallons annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before November 14, 1986

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before December 14, 1986

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before November 14, 1989

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before December 14, 1989
