12. Remarks: For use other than irrigation or stock watering, state number and type of units to be served or annual consumptive use. This maps has been filed under Permit 27221. This is a new application to appropriate an additional 300 gallons per day per mobile home. There are 54 mobile homes being served by this water system and a Certificate was issued limited to 300 gallons per day per mobile home. Since 1980 the water usage has varied depending upon the hydrogeological cycle. The 5.91 million gallons per annum is not sufficient to serve the mobile homes and landscaped area within the mobile home park. During a dry year the water usage could amount to almost 12 million gallons per annum. This permit is being requested so that there will be sufficient water on an annual basis to serve this 54 unit mobile home park. There will not be any wasting of water but there has to be sufficient water to maintain the common area.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level at permittee's well due to other ground water development in the area. A measuring device must be installed and measurements of water use kept. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening for measuring depth to water. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water granted herein at any and all times.

This Permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

No perforations shall be put in the production casing from ground level to 100 feet.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 27221 and 48014 shall not exceed 11.8 million gallons annually.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and

not to exceed 0.10 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 11.8 million gallons annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 17, 1986

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before November 17, 1986

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before October 17, 1988

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before November 17, 1988
