Point of diversion, manner of use, and/or place of use
of water heretofore appropriated under permit #34978

1. The source of water is Leach Canyon Creek
Name of stream, lake, underground spring or other source.

2. The amount of water to be changed 0.644 C.F.S.

6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 36 T31N R36E MDB&M or at a point from which the NE corner of said sec. 36 bears N33°30'E 3,532.8'
If point of diversion is not changed, do not answer.

7. Proposed place of use SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 36 T31N R36E MDB&M 4.870 acres
Describe by legal subdivisions. If for irrigation state number of acres to be irrigated.

8. Existing place of use SE 1/4 Sec. 36 T31N R36E MDB&M 160 acres
Describe by legal subdivisions. If permit is for irrigation, state number of acres irrigated. If changing place of use and/or manner of use of irrigation permit, describe acreage to be removed from irrigation.


9. Use will be from January 1 to December 31 of each year.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of Leach Canyon Creek as heretofore granted under Permit 34978 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 34978 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. A substantial headgate and measuring device must be installed and maintained to facilitate the measurement and control of water. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water under this proposed change at any and all times.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.644 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed a yearly duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before December 20, 1985

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before January 20, 1986

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before December 20 1986

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before January 20, 1987

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before January 20, 1987

Completion of work filed MAR 04 1986

Proof of beneficial use filed MAR 4 1986

Cultural map filed AUG 31 1984
