, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public

waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.)

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is an underground source

The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point within the SW1/4 of the NE1/4 of Section 32, Township 19 South, Range 60 East, M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the Center Quarter (C1/4) survey, and by course and distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be so stated. corner of said Section 32 bears South 72°02'42" West a distance of 1247.14 feet.

6. Place of use within the SW1/4 of the NE1/4 of Section 32, Township 19 South, Range 60 East, M.D.B.&M., approximately two and one half (2-1/2) acres.

7. Use will begin about January 1st and end about December 31st, of each year.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to existing rights and is further subject to revocation if and when water can be furnished by an entity such as a water district or a municipality engaged in furnishing water. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of water begins, or before the Proof of Completion of Work is filed. It is understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening for measuring depth to water. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.04 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 1.4 million gallons annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before February 8, 1987

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before March 8, 1987

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before February 8, 1990

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before March 8, 1990
