- 1. The source of water is an underground source
2. The amount of water to be changed 0.0489 c.f.s.
3. The water to be used for irrigation and domestic purposes
4. The water heretofore permitted for irrigation and domestic purposes
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point within the NW1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 12, T.21S., R.53E., M.D.B.&M., Pahrump Valley Basin, Nye County, Nevada...
6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within The NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 7, T.21S., R.54E., M.D.B.&M., Pahrump Valley Basin, Nye County, Nevada...
7. Proposed place of use is a portion of the NW 1/4, NE 1/4 of Section 12, Township 21 South, Range 53 East, M.D.B.&M., Pahrump Valley Basin, Nye County, Nevada (being four acres).
8. Existing place of use West Half (W 1/2) of Section 7, Township 21 South, Range 54 East, M.D.B.&M., Pahrump Valley Basin, Nye County, Nevada (being four acres) to be removed from the West Half (W1/2 of Section 7 Township 21 South, Range 54 East.
9. Use will be from January 1st to December 31st of each year.
10. Use was permitted from January 1st to December 31st of each year.
11. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) Existing well with an eight (8) inch diameter casing and five horse power submersible pump.
12. Estimated cost of works \$25,000.00
13. Estimated time required to construct works Three years

14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use Five years

15. Remarks: For use other than irrigation or stock watering, state number and type of units to be served or annual consumptive use.

The four (4) acres of water rights shall be removed (from Permit No. 24690)  
upon approval of this application to change the point of Diversion and

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 24690, Certificate 7016 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 24690, Certificate 7016 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.0489 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 20 acre-feet annually, and not to exceed a yearly duty of 5.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before February 8, 1993

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before March 8, 1993

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before February 8, 1996

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before March 8, 1996

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before March 8, 1996
