..... APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 31424 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 31424 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a weir or other type of measuring device at or near the well to facilitate the measurement and control of the water. If well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water under this proposed change at any and all times.

This Permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

Any cancellation or withdrawal of this permit will result in the water reverting to the source and not the base right.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed..... 5.4 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 1280 acre-feet annually, and not to exceed a yearly duty of 4 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before..... January 9, 1992.....

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before..... February 9, 1992.....

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before..... January 9, 1994.....
