APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 46095 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 46095 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a weir or other type of measuring device at or near the well to facilitate the measurement and control of the water. If well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water under this proposed change at any and all times.

This Permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

No perforations shall be put in the production casing from ground level to 100 feet.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 48375 and 46095 shall not exceed 468 acre-feet per year.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal, and local agencies.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 1.59 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed a yearly duty of 3.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before February 19, 1986

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before March 19, 1986

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before February 19, 1987

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before March 19, 1987

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before March 19, 1987
