Identify right in Decree.)

1. The source of water is underground

2. The amount of water to be changed 0.67 second feet

3. The water to be used for mining, milling and domestic

4. The water heretofore permitted for mining, processing and domestic

5. The water is to be diverted at the following point within the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 (Lot 16) of Section 17, T.36N., R.41E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the south east corner of said Section 17 bears S. 44°56'36"E. 299.8 feet.

6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within NW 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Section 17, (Lot 10), T.36N., R.41E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the South 1/4 Corner of said Section 17 bears S. 12°50'47"W. 1591.6 feet.

7. Proposed place of use Same as Existing Place of Use

8. Existing place of use Section 18 A11 and Section 17 A11, T.36N., R.41E., M.D.B.&M.

9. Use will be from January 1 to December 31 of each year.

10. Use was permitted from January 1 to December 31 of each year.

11. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) Drilled and cased well with a shaft turbine pump and motor, discharging to a 6-inch diameter pipeline which will convey the water to storage tanks at the processing plant.

12. Estimated cost of works Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000).

13. Estimated time required to construct works Two (2) Years

14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use... Three (3) Years

15. Remarks: For use other than irrigation or stock watering, state number and type of units to be served or annual consumptive use.

This application could be comingled with other permits so that the total withdrawal will not exceed one (1) second foot. All process waters will be recycled to minimize fresh water requirements.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and manner of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 45771 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 45771 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

No perforations shall be put in the production casing from ground level to 100 feet.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 45769, 45770, 48642 and 48643 shall not exceed 235.9 million gallons annually.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.67 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 145.0 million gallons annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before December 27, 1985

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before January 27, 1986

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before December 27, 1987

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before January 27, 1988

## (PERMIT TERMS CONTINUED)

This permit is issued under the preferred use provisions of NRS Chapter 534. The manner of use of water under this permit is by nature of its activity a temporary use and any application to change the manner of use granted under this permit will be subject to additional determination and evaluation with respect to the permanent effects on existing rights and the resource within the ground water basin.

This Permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.
