APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion of the waters of South Fork of Humboldt River as heretofore granted under Permit 24881, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 24881 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. A measuring device must be installed and measurements of water use kept.

This reservoir permit is also issued specifically subject to the terms of the State Engineer's Ruling dated May 20, 1970 and NRS 535.010. Beneficial use must be made through secondary permits as provided in NRS 533.340.

The amount of water to be stored shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 120,000 acre-feet per second annum.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before July 31, 1988

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before August 31, 1988

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before July 31, 1991

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before August 31, 1991
