4. The water heretofore permitted for QUASI MUNICIPAL AND DOMESTIC  
Irrigation, power, mining, industrial, etc. If for stock state number and kind of animals.

5. The water is to be diverted at the following point IN THE NW 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Section 26,  
Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey and by course and  
T 9 N, R 45 E, MDM or at a point from which the South 1/2 corner of  
said Section 26 bears S 28° 40' 53" W a distance of 2,697.3 feet.

6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within the SE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Section 26,  
If point of diversion is not changed, do not answer.

A residential, recreational development is being planned for the Belmont area with an estimated annual consumptive use of 32 million gallons. Tentative plans include 50 permanent residences along with a 30 unit RV park with landscaping irrigation. Estimated consumption is 61 GPM, 24 hrs./day, 365 days per year.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion of the waters of Belmont Spring heretofore granted under Permit 48271 is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the 0.135 c.f.s. herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to a beneficial use. A suitable measuring device must be installed and accurate measurements of the water placed to a beneficial use must be included in the proof of such use when filed. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This Permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

This permit is subject to the condition that the permittee must ensure that wildlife which have customarily used such water will have access thereto, NRS 533.367.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.135 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 32.0 million gallons annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before December 16, 1988

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before January 16, 1989

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before December 16, 1990

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before January 16, 1991

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before January 16, 1991
