TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF NEVADA

The applicant BOARD OF NYE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

P.O. BOX 153, of TONOPAH, NEVADA 89049

hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.)

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is underground - Big Smoky Valley

2. The amount of water applied for is 25 c.f.s. second-feet

(a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet

3. The water to be used for quasi-municipal purposes

4. If use is for:

(a) Irrigation, state number of acres to be irrigated

(b) Stockwater, state number and kinds of animals to be watered Rodeo stock in conjunction with sanctioned County events.

(c) Other use (describe fully under "No. 12. Remarks")

(d) Power:

(1) Horsepower developed

(2) Point of return of water to stream

5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point in the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 30,

T. 11N., R. 43E., M.D.B. & M., from whence the E 1/4 Corner of said Section 30, bears S. 33°13'15" E., 665.47 feet distant.

6. Place of use in the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 30, T. 11N., R. 43E., M.D.B. & M.

7. Use will begin about January 1st and end about December 31st, of each year.

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) it is proposed to drill, case and equip an underground well for quasi-municipal purposes.

9. Estimated cost of works \$20,000.00

10. Estimated time required to construct works 1 year
If well completed, describe works.

11. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use 1 year

12. Remarks: For use other than irrigation or stock watering, state number and type of units to be served or annual consumptive use.

The use will be quasi-municipal in conjunction with a park and recreational facility for the Big Smoky Valley area.

APPROVAL.....OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to existing rights. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of water begins, or before the Proof of Completion of Work is filed. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer, pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This Permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This permit is issued under the provisions of NRS 534.120(2) as a preferred use. The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and

not to exceed 0.25 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 6.0 million gallons annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before April 16, 1987

Proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before May 16, 1987

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before April 16, 1989

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before May 16, 1989

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before May 16, 1989

Completion of work filed JUL 31 1987

Proof of beneficial use filed 10-16-90
