APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 36103 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 36103 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 49432 and 49433 shall not exceed 156.8 acre-feet annually.

This Permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

No perforations shall be put in the production casing from ground level to 100 feet.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

At least two groundwater monitoring wells are to be installed within the place of use of Permits 49432 and 49433 at locations satisfactory to the State Engineer, before any diversion of water from the production wells takes place. The monitoring wells must be suitably cased, perforated, sealed and capped and must penetrate at least 75 feet below the water table.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.2625 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 156.8 acre-feet annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before March 31, 1987

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before May 1, 1987

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before March 31, 1987

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before May 1, 1987

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before May 1, 1987
