Point of Diversion and Place of Use of a portion Point of diversion, manner of use, and/or place of use

of water heretofore appropriated under Permit 25690, Certificate 9215 (Identify existing right by Permit, Certificate, Proof or Claim Nos. If Decreed, give title of Decree and

identify right in Decrees.)

1. The source of water is Underground Name of stream, lake, underground spring or other source.

2. The amount of water to be changed 1.32 c.f.s. Second feet, acre feet. One second foot equals 448.83 gallons per minute.

3. The water to be used for Irrigation and Domestic Irrigation, power, mining, industrial, etc. If for stock state number and kind of animals.

4. The water heretofore permitted for Irrigation and Domestic Irrigation, power, mining, industrial, etc. If for stock state number and kind of animals.

5. The water is to be diverted at the following point NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 3, T. 11N., R. 23E. Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey and, by course and MDB&M, or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 3 distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be stated. bears North 63°09'39" East, a distance of 2,891.48 feet.

6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 12, T. 11N., R. 23E. If point of diversion is not changed, do not answer. MDB&M, or at a point from which the W 1/2 corner of Section 13, T. 11N., R. 23E., MDB&M bears South 1°05'10" West, 5,177.72 feet.

7. Proposed place of use N 1/2 NE 1/4 Section 3, T. 11N., R. 23E., MDB&M (80 acres) Describe by legal subdivisions. If for irrigation state number of acres to be irrigated.

8. Existing place of use SW 1/4 Section 12, T. 11N., R. 23E., MDB&M (33.87 Acres SW 1/4 SW 1/4, 20.56 Acres SE 1/4 SW 1/4, 12.20 Acres NW 1/4 SW 1/4, 13.37 Acres NE 1/4 SW 1/4 to be removed), S 1/2 NW 1/4 Section 12, T. 11N., R. 23E., M.D.B. & M. Describe by legal subdivisions. If permit is for irrigation, state number of acres irrigated. If changing place of use and/or manner of use of irrigation permit, describe acreage to be removed from irrigation.

9. Use will be from January 1 to December 31 of each year. Month and Day Month and Day

10. Use was permitted from January 1 to December 31 of each year. Month and Day Month and Day

11. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) Drilled well, pump, and electric motor, and wheel-moved sprinkler system. State manner in which water is to be diverted, i.e. diversion structure, ditches, pipes and flumes, or drilled well, etc.

The ground water to be changed by this application will not be supplemental to any surface water rights which may be provided by the Walker River Decree on the proposed place of use.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 25690, Certificate 9215 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 25690, Certificate 9215 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a measuring device must be installed in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 49446 and 49447 shall not exceed 320 acre-feet annually.

This Permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 1.32 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 320 acre-feet annually, but not to exceed a yearly duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from any and/or all sources.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before April 27, 1987

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before May 27, 1987

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before April 27, 1989

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before May 27, 1989

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before May 27, 1989

Proof of beneficial use filed SEP 22 1988
