The applicant DONALD A. WALLACE and EVELYN WALLACE as their community property P.O. Box 10096, of Santa Ana, California 92711, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated.

- 1. The source of the proposed appropriation is LOWER WILD HORSE SPRING (Owners name)
2. The amount of water applied for is 0.03 second-feet
3. The water to be used for DOMESTIC
4. If use is for: (a) Irrigation, state number of acres to be irrigated
5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point SW 1/4 of SE 1/4, Sec. 9
6. Place of use SW 1/4 Sec. 9, SE 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of the SE 1/4 and the W 1/2 of the SE 1/4 of the SE 1/4 and the SW 1/4 of the SE 1/4 and the S 1/2 of the SE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Sec. 8, all the above in T. 1 N., R. 33 E., M.D.M.
7. Use will begin about January 1 and end about December 31, of each year.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the .03 c.f.s., herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to a beneficial use. A suitable measuring device must be installed and accurate measurements of the water placed to a beneficial use must be included in the proof of such use when filed. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This Permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

This permit is subject to the condition that the permittee must ensure that wildlife which have customarily used such water will have access thereto, NRS 533.367.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.03 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 0.657 million gallons annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 16, 1988.

Proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before November 16, 1988.

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before October 16, 1989.

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before November 16, 1989.

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before N/A.
