6. Place of use Power House located in the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec.17, T.37 N., R.61 E., M.D.B.&M.; From whence the water is returned to Trout Creek in the same subdivision.

7. Use will begin about May 1 and end about September 30, of each year

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) Headgate, diversion box, 15" plastic pipe, and Forebay
