hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.)

Incorporated in Nevada on December 22, 1972.

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Underground - Hot Artesian Well runoff

2. The amount of water applied for is 1.0 c.f.s. second-feet

3. The water to be used for Industrial & Domestic

5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 15, T.15N., R.25E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 15 bears North 0°54'30" West, 3156.90 feet.

6. Place of use SW 1/4 Section 15, N 1/2 SE 1/4, SW 1/4 SE 1/4, SW 1/4 Section 16, N 1/2 Section 20, NW 1/4, N 1/2 SW 1/4, Section 21, all in T.15N., R.25E., M.D.B. & M.

7. Use will begin about January 1 and end about December 31, of each year.

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) Ditches picking up existing runoff and conveying it to and through the Place of Use.

9. Estimated cost of works \$500

10. Estimated time required to construct works..... Completed
If well completed, describe works.

11. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use..... Five years

12. Remarks: For use other than irrigation or stock watering, state number and type of units to be served or annual consumptive use. This application is filed for runoff from the use of water under Permit 30866 by Tad's Enterprises, Inc., successor to Agri-Technology Corporation. Alexander Dawson, Inc., holds the right to use 1.0 c.f.s. of water from this source as outlined in Document 32993 files in Lyon County which is also on file in the Division of Water Resources' file under Permit 30866. The desire of Alexander Dawson, Inc., at this time is to secure a right to the runoff water when it is available from the Tad's operation. This is not an application to appropriate new water or for transfer of rights presently in the name of Tad's Enterprises, Inc.

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This secondary permit is issued subject to existing rights. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. A measuring device must be installed and maintained and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use.

Authorization to divert and consumptively use the water under this permit is allowed only as a secondary use and is subject to the terms and conditions of Permits 51547 and 56007. After the water has first been used beneficially for industrial power generation, the water may then be used beneficially for wildlife habitat enhancement. If the Primary Permits 51547 and 56007 for this well, Old Artesian Well No. 1 are cancelled or withdrawn, or if the primary use of water is no longer needed, this permit will be simultaneously rescinded.

(PERMIT TERMS CONTINUED)

The combined diversion rates of water under Permits 49690, 51547, 56007, and 62460 shall not exceed 3.7 cubic feet per second.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

Monthly records shall be kept of the amount of water pumped from this well and the records submitted to the State Engineer on a quarterly basis within 15 days after the end of each calendar quarter.
