The water of Jefferson Creek & Tributaries is already permitted to the applicant under Permit #24442. With this application, we are not asking for any more water, but to use the existing water to put more land under irrigation by using sound conservation practices.

Part of the place of use in this application, which is native meadow and not included in Permit #24442, is already being irrigated by tailwater from Jefferson Creek. The waters of Jefferson Creek & Tributaries will be combined with our permitted underground well water to irrigate the total 1,280 acres. (640 acres are patented and deeded to the applicant; 320 acres is a Desert Land Entry for Richard L. Carver; and 320 acres is also a DLE for Margaret A. Carver.)

We do not waive any vested right that may be pertanent to Jefferson Creek & Tributaries used prior to 1913.
