TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF NEVADA

The applicant Flying M Ranch, an equal and undivided co-holder with U.S.D.I. Bureau of Land Management, 1535 Hot Spgs., Ste.300, of Carson City, Nevada 89701, hereby make application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.)

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is underground (Baldwin Canyon Well) Name of stream, lake, spring, underground or other source

2. The amount of water applied for is 0.03 C.F.S. second-feet One second-foot equals 448.83 gals. per min. (a) If stored in reservoir give number of acre-feet

3. The water to be used for Stockwatering Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic, or other use. Must limit to one use.

4. If use is for: (a) Irrigation, state number of acres to be irrigated (b) Stockwater, state number and kinds of animals to be watered 1,000 head cattle (c) Other use (describe fully under "No. 12. Remarks" (d) Power: (1) Horsepower developed (2) Point of return of water to stream

5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point within SE 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 23, T.7 N., R. 27 E., MDB&M, Nevada or at a point from which the south one quarter corner of survey, and by course and distance to a section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be so stated. Section 23, T. 7 N., R. 27 E., Bears S59° 28' 00" E. A distance of 801.51 feet.

6. Place of use SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 23, T. 7 N., R. 27 E., MDB&M, Nevada Describe by legal subdivision. If on unsurveyed land, it should be so stated.

7. Use will begin about January 1st and end about December 31st, of each year. Month and Day

8. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) drilled 6" cased well submersible pump, 5000 gallon storage tank, 4-450 gallon steel stock troughs. APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the period of use and the average number of livestock served from the waters of this source. It is further understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level at permittee's well due to any other ground water development in the area. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening for measuring depth to water. If well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times but does not take responsibility for the use of the Federal range.

This Permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.03 cubic feet per second, or sufficient to water 1000 head of cattle.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 9, 1987

Proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before November 9, 1987

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before October 9, 1989

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before November 9, 1989
