The plant will be a 50 yard per hr. placer plant consisting of a trommel and gravity separation devices which will use the same water in the amount of 10,000 gallons per HR., with an additional 2,000 to 3,000 gallons of water used for plant

APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the 0.12 c.f.s., herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to a beneficial use. A suitable measuring device must be installed and accurate measurements of the water placed to a beneficial use must be included in the proof of such use when filed. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This Permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

This permit is subject to the condition that the permittee must ensure that wildlife which have customarily used such water will have access thereto, NRS 533.367.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The manner of use of water under this permit is by nature of its activity a temporary use and any application to change the manner of use granted under this permit will be subject to additional determination and evaluation with respect to the flow from the Spring and the actual water placed to beneficial use.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.12 cubic feet per second, but not to exceed 4.2 million gallons annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before November 14, 1987

Proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before December 14, 1987

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before November 14, 1988

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before December 14, 1988


