1. The source of water is Underground Name of stream, lake, underground spring or other source.

2. The amount of water to be changed 0.059 cfs Second feet, acre feet. One second foot equals 448.83 gallons per minute.

3. The water to be used for Quasi Municipal and Domestic Purposes Irrigation, power, mining, industrial, etc. If for stock state number and kind of animals.

4. The water heretofore permitted for Irrigation and Domestic Purposes Irrigation, power, mining, industrial, etc. If for stock state number and kind of animals.

5. The water is to be diverted at the following point in the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 29, T. 20 N., R. 53 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 29 bears S. 84°27'14" E. 484.7 feet.

6. The existing permitted point of diversion is located within the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 33, T. 21 1/2 N., R. 54 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 33 bears S. 33°00' E. 180 feet.

7. Proposed place of use Lot 15 and Lot 16 (S 1/2 SE 1/4) Section 29, T. 20 N., R. 53 E., M.D.B. & M.

8. Existing place of use Portion NE 1/4 Section 33, T. 21 1/2 N., R. 54 E., M.D.B. & M. 4.5 acres from the north portion of lot 1 and lot 2, Section 33, T. 21 1/2 N., R. 54 E., M.D.B. & M. being stripped.

9. Use will be from January 1 to December 31 of each year.

10. Use was permitted from January 1 to December 31 of each year.

11. Description of proposed works. (Under the provisions of NRS 535.010 you may be required to submit plans and specifications of your diversion or storage works.) drilled well, pump, storage tank, pipe lines to places of use.

12. Estimated cost of works \$30,000

13. Estimated time required to construct works 3 years

APPROVAL..... OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use and manner of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 46677 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 46677 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This Permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

If this permit is cancelled or withdrawn the water right under this permit will revert to the source.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed..... 0.059 ..... cubic feet per second , but not to exceed 5.865 million gallons annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before..... January 27, 1989 .....

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before..... February 27, 1989 .....

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before..... January 27, 1990 .....

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before..... February 27, 1990 .....

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before..... February 27, 1990 .....
