1. The source of water is Underground Name of stream, lake, underground spring or other source.

2. The amount of water to be changed 0.008 cfs Second foot, acre feet. One second foot equals 448.83 gallons per minute.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the Place of Use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 44904 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 44904 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening for measuring depth to water. If well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State retains the right to regulate the use of water herein granted at any and all times but does not take responsibility for the use of the Federal range.

This Permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This permit is issued under the provisions of NRS 534.120(2) as a preferred use.

The amount of water to be changed shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.008 cubic feet per second, or sufficient to water 233 head of cattle and 40 horses.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before August 2, 1987

Proof of completion of work shall be filed before September 2, 1987

Application of water to beneficial use shall be made on or before August 2, 1988

Proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before September 2, 1988

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before N/A
